INDUSTRIAL VISIT REPORT

Industrial Visit to Milma Dairy Unit, Kollam

Organized by: Department of Commerce, ED Club, MMNSS College, Kottiyam, Kollam

Date of Visit: 26th November 2018

Participants: 48 Students, 2 Teaching Faculties

The Department of Commerce and ED Club MMNSS College, Kottiyam, Kollam, organized an industrial visit to the Milma Dairy Unit, Kollam, on 26th November 2018. The visit aimed to provide students with first-hand experience in the processing of various milk products and to enhance their understanding of the operations and management of a modern dairy plant.

Objectives of the Visit

1. To acquire practical knowledge of milk product processing.
2. To understand the functioning and operations of a dairy unit.
3. To gain insights into the quality control measures implemented in milk processing.
4. To comprehend the role of technology and automation in the dairy industry.

Overview of Milma Dairy Unit, Kollam

Milma (Kerala Co-operative Milk Marketing Federation) is a well-known name in Kerala for providing quality dairy products. The Kollam unit of Milma is one of the significant plants engaged in the production and distribution of milk and its by-products. The plant is equipped with modern machinery and follows stringent quality control measures to ensure that the products meet industry standards.

Summary of Activities

1. **Orientation Session:**

The visit commenced with a brief orientation session conducted by the Milma team. The students were introduced to the history of Milma, its operations, and the various products processed at the unit. The orientation also covered the importance of hygiene and quality control in the dairy industry.
2. **Tour of the Processing Unit:**

The students were taken on a guided tour of the processing unit, where they observed various stages of milk processing, including:
