FREEDOM WALL - 2022



35 participants from Physics and Chemistry were present for the Webinar and teachers from the dept's also participated in the Webinar.


The session was neatly handled keeping in mind the need of the students. This talk was organized to generate an awareness for Research in the student community.

PALLIATIVE CARE ACTIVITIES

MMNSS College, Kottiyam having an active Students Palliative Club with NSS Unit (Unit No. 37 A & B), as part of enhancing its community outreach activities. The growing instances of cancer in society, and the pain and suffering of the patients are a matter of deep concern to all. As an educational institution, it is our responsibility to reach out to the needs of the population. In order to create a sense of social responsibility and sensitize young minds to become more caring and humane, a Palliative Care Club was formed in our college. Engaging students in the

Palliative care program at once brings out the volunteer in them and gives them an exposure to dimensions of life. It helps in overall personality development of the students. It increases the interaction between this educational institution and the neighboring population creating a bond of trust and goodness between the two.

ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN BY THE STUDENT PALLIATIVE CLUBS

UNIVERSITY LEVEL TRAINING

The aim of the online training program conducted by Pallium India Trust in association with NSS was to make student volunteers eligible to provide basic social responds and to develop future generation with social responsibility. It was a six day program from 1/11/2021 to 6/11/2021 which was conducted by Babu Abraham and Dr. A. Shaji. The program started from 10 am and ended at 12 pm. The volunteers Sreelekshmi G Prasad and Chandraj.K.S from MMNSS college (Unit no.37 A &B) participated in the entire program.

During the period of online training, they gained knowledge of basic palliative care through twelve hours of dedicated and interactive sessions through Trivandrum Institute of Palliative Science-Extension for Community Healthcare Outcome (TIPS-ECHO) Certificate programme. The chairman is Dr. M.R. Rajagopal, Sri.Siddik.R is the Director, Department of Student Services, Dr. Shaji.A. is the Progrmme Coordinator. Sri.Babu Abraham is the facilitator of this program.

DISTRICT LEVEL TRAINING

The aim of the online training programme conducted by Pallium India Trust in association with NSS was to make student volunteers eligible to provide basic social support, companionship to patients and to develop future generation with social responsibility. It was a six day program from November 15 to November 20, 2021 which was coordinated by SreePriya.S. The program started from 10 am and ended at 12 pm. The volunteers namely Haadhiya.S, Sandra Saji, Karthika.A, and Keerthana B.S (Unit no.37 A &B) participated in the entire programme.

On the first day (November 15), the program was conducted by Dr.Sreedevi on palliative care, essential principles of palliative care, need for palliative care and different models of palliative care delivery. Second day was guided by Ms.BincyBabu on 'Communication'. Third day was conducted by Dr.Sheeba,RS on topic 'Home based Palliative Care', components, need, services, and types of home based palliative care. Mr.Bharath Mohan supervised session of fourth day on the concept of SANS pain and student initiative in palliative care. Day 5 session was conducted by Mr.Babu Abraham on psycho social support and community participation. Students also come to know about the importance of psychosocial care, its components, concept of neighborhood network in palliative care (NNPC) and Compassionate Community Care (CCC), Community Based Palliative Care (CBPC), different types of community support and role of community volunteers. On the last day, Ms.Ashla Rani guided the class. A testimony of SIPC volunteers and a feedback session from students and an action plan was performed. The entire training programme was a huge success in making students eligible for giving support to the deserved ones.

UNIT LEVEL TRAINING/AWARENESS PROGRAMME

With the help of University Level and District Level training of palliative students support, our unit had an opportunity to share their training ideas on palliative care to whole NSS volunteers during the NSS summer camp. The whole students could get ample opportunity to get an idea about palliative care, essential principles of palliative care, need for palliative care and different models of palliative care delivery.

HOME VISITS


As a part of palliative club initiatives, our NSS volunteers regularly visit the house of palliative persons and give necessary help which is needed for them. By continuous contact, our volunteers would know the needs and demands of them and always interact with the patients and their families to provide moral support for them. Having time to hear their sides makes them cheerful. We also get to know about their medical condition after their check up.



SUPPLY OF MEDICINES

Mayyanad Panchayath comprises 23 wards. The Health Inspector discussed the palliative requirements of the patients residing in each ward. All of them need Diapers, wipes and some medicines. According to their needs we bought large number of Adult diapers from wholesale shop mainly large and medium sized. With the assistance of Asha workers, our

volunteers along with Programme officers visited the patient's home and supplied 30 Diapers for each 17 bed ridden patients and wipes for 10 palliative patients.



DISTRIBUTION OF FOOD KITS

As per the data collected from Asha workers in our Panchayath 18 families need food items. So we decided to contribute seven basic items in a kit, mainly Rice, Pulses, Gram, Tea powder, Sugar, coconut oil and Oats. We visited these families while distributing the foodkits and all of them have very low economic status.



DISTRIBUTION OF CLOTHS AND OTHER NECESSITIES

Sharing of resources to others is a greatest thing that we done in our life. As a part of our NSS seven days camp, we have also get chance to serve inmates in SS Samithi care centre, Kottiyam where people are dealing with mental illness and destitute. The main motive of this care centre is to get back the illness people to common life. Mr.Francis Xavier sir who lead this centre to a great vision and mission. The experience we get from there was very heart touching. And we also share our interest to take part in their initiatives and also deliver the food items and cloths. It was a heart touching moment in life.
