

Industrial Visit to Milma Dairy Unit, Kollam

The Department of Commerce and ED Club MMNSS College, Kottiyam, Kollam, organized an industrial visit to the Milma Dairy Unit, Kollam, on 26th November 2018. The visit aimed to provide students with first-hand experience in the processing of various milk products and to enhance their understanding of the operations and management of a modern dairy plant.

Overview of Milma Dairy Unit, Kollam

Milma (Kerala Co-operative Milk Marketing Federation) is a well-known name in Kerala for providing quality dairy products. The Kollam unit of Milma is one of the significant plants engaged in the production and distribution of milk and its by-products. The plant is equipped with modern machinery and follows stringent quality control measures to ensure that the products meet industry standards.

Summary of Activities

The visit commenced with a brief orientation session conducted by the Milma team. 1. Orientation Session: The students were introduced to the history of Milma, its operations, and the various products processed at the unit. Learning Outcomes


The industrial visit provided valuable insights into the following areas:
