## **ACTION TAKEN REPORT**

## Students Satisfaction Survey 2018-19

Based on the feedback made by the students on the internal academic evaluation and institutional facilities, more than 95 % of students responded that the syllabus was covered in the class. 97% of students have responded that the teachers were well prepared for the classes. 97% of students reported that communication skill of the teachers has improved over the period, only 3% has negatively responded to the above statement, which could be rectified with more personalized teaching processes. Majority of the students positively responded to the internal evaluation process. 88 % of students responded that the syllabus followed and the curricular activities provided by the institution had enabled them to grow emotionally and cognitively. The initiatives taken by the teachers in providing extra-curricular activities had been found helpful by majority of students. 86s% students agreed that teachers were successful in using student centric methods like experimental learning, participative learning and problem- solving methodologies. Another 75% of students stated the teachers were able to provide training in life skills and soft skills, which the students could use in their future career development. Majority of the students positively responded that the institution was able to collect feedback from them and take active interest in providing the necessary responses. 87% of students responded that the teachers were successful in implementing e-learning methods. The active involvement of the institution and teachers in encouraging the students to join the Social Service Schemes had been positively responded by more than 92% students. Majority of the students agreed that the academic atmosphere provided by the institution and the teachers has enabled them to contribute more time and energy to their education and career development, the guidance provided by the teachers have also helped students in improving their studies and to set long term goals. Majority have positively responded that the overall education and extra-curricular activities provided by the institution and teachers are good or excellent.
