## Report on Research Methodology Workshop (2019-2020)

The Department of English conducted a one-day workshop on research methodology. The session aimed to familiarize students with key aspects of research, focusing on how to select a topic, write a thesis statement, and formulate objectives and aims. The workshop also introduced students to different research methods used in literary and linguistic studies.

The first session on **topic selection** emphasized identifying researchable and manageable topics relevant to the students' areas of interest. Following this, the **thesis statement writing** session highlighted the importance of creating a clear and arguable statement that encapsulates the central argument of the research. Students then learned to distinguish between **objectives and aims**, ensuring their research was focused and clearly defined.

The workshop also covered **research methods**, exploring qualitative, quantitative, and mixed-method approaches. Students learned about textual analysis, discourse analysis, and comparative studies, among others, to determine the most suitable method for their project.

A significant portion of the workshop focused on citation styles, particularly MLA 8th edition. The session covered in-text citations and the proper format for a Works Cited page, with practical exercises provided for better understanding.

The workshop received positive feedback from students, who appreciated the handson approach and found it helpful in preparing for their final year UG research projects.
